It's not a real master's degree
– **No.** It's exactly the same as the on-campus equivalent.

The online MSc is a 'poor relation' to the on-campus MSc – **No.** The online programme has undergone lengthy pedagogy research, development and design, so you're getting the King's College London experience – just delivered in a different way.

You need a background in psychiatry or neuroscience to do an online MSc at the IoPPN – **No.** Although it can be beneficial in some cases, it's not a pre-requisite to applying. What's more important are your current and previous experiences and what you're hoping to achieve from your studies.

You won't have the true King's/IoPPN experience as an online student – **No.** You can enter the campus (if you're nearby) and online students automatically gain access to our library resources, careers service, the student union and an invitation to the graduation ceremony in London.

Only someone who's a computer whizz can do their master's online – **No.** You will of course need to feel comfortable with performing basic online tasks such as typing, uploading and downloading documents but your Student Success Advisor is on-hand to help you if you get stuck.

You can only access study materials from a desktop computer – **No.** You can access your materials from any mobile device including a laptop, tablet or mobile phone. Whatever works best for you!



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The certificate states that it's delivered online – **No.** Nowhere will it show that you studied your degree online. We know that this is important for many of you, especially our international students.



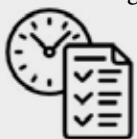
